33 percent of Brazilian households have internet access

The Digital Inclusion Map survey, jointly developed by the Getulio Vargas Foundation and Telefonica Foundation, has revealed that 33 percent of Brazilian homes have internet access. This puts the country in 63th place among 158 nations mapped. Iceland is in the lead with 94 percent of households connected. According to the study, the city of Sao Caetano (state of Rio de Janeiro) has the highest rate of internet access in Brazil at 69 percent. At the other end of the table appears Aroeiras, in the state of Piaui, where the rate is zero.

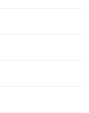
