

Record '36% of Brazilians' at risk of going hungry[Clique aqui para ver a notícia no site](#)

Risk of going hungry in Brazil is higher than ever, a new study shows, as percentage of people unable to afford food rose to record 36% last year

Food prices have risen sharply following Russias assault on Ukraine, says economist Marcelo Neri, even though the Latin American country is one of the worlds top agricultural goods producers.

The risk of going hungry in Brazil is higher than ever, as the percentage of people unable to afford food for themselves or their family at some point during the last 12 months rose to a record 36 percent in 2021, from 30 percent in 2019, according to a new study.

It is the first time that food insecurity in Latin Americas largest food producer has surpassed the world average since the data tracking began in 2006, according to a new analysis of Gallup World Poll data released on Wednesday by the Getulio Vargas Foundation (FGV), a Brazilian academic institution.
